THE FEDERATED GARDEN CLUBS OF VERMONT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION PROCESS

Federated Garden Clubs of Vermont (FGCV) Scholarship

- 1) A one-year scholarship of \$1,000 is available to juniors, seniors and graduate students pursuing a master's degree.
- 2) Sophomores may make application for their junior year.
- College/university must be accredited and listed on the official website of the U.S. Department of Education.
- 4) List of extracurricular activities over the past three years from high school and/or college limit two (2) pages, front side only to go with the application form.
- 5) Letter from applicant stating goals, background, financial need, and commitment to chosen field of study limit one (1) page, front side only.
- 6) Official transcript, two (2) letters of recommendation, one of which must attest to academic achievement limit one (1) page each, front side only.
- 7) After the specified application deadline, the chairperson, along with other designated members of the FGCV will review all the applications received and choose the winner. The Federated Garden Clubs of Vermont Scholarship is awarded at the June FGCV annual meeting.
- 8) The Scholarship chairperson notifies all applicants regarding the National Garden Club Scholarship Award

Applicant Eligibility:

Applicants must meet all the following criteria:

- 1) Must be a US Citizen or Permanent Legal Resident of the US and a resident of the State of Vermont
- 2) International or Foreign Exchange Students are not eligible.
- 3) Doctoral program students are not eligible.
- 4) Must be attending school full-time as defined by the Federated Garden Clubs of Vermont:
- 5) Undergraduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 graded hours of classes. Graduate students must be enrolled for a minimum of 9 graded hours of classes.
- 6) Must have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.25 on a 4.0 scale.
- 7) Must be planning a career related to gardening, landscape design, environmental issues, floral design, or horticulture.
- 8) Must be MAJORING in one of the following fields of study. Agronomy Agriculture Education Floriculture Horticulture Landscape Design

Botany, Biology Forestry Plant Pathology Science City (Rural/Urban) Planning Habitat or Forest/Systems Ecology Environmental Concerns Environmental Conservation Land Management Wildlife Science
